## Cabin Guidelines

To encourage our Guests to be respectful of their accommodation at Fire Mountain and to avoid any additional charges we have provided these guidelines. We trust that you will treat your Cabin as if it were your own and that you will leave your Cabin clean, neat and undamaged at check-out. To accomplish this we encourage the following:

Please be responsible with Fires in your fireplace. Please, do not burn fires larger than the first fire that we set for you. Make sure the fireplace screen covers the fireplace at all times to avoid damage from sparks. You can accomplish this by leaning the screen forward from the base when you want to add wood or tend the fire.

Maid services are provided by request.

I will make sure THE FIRE IS COMPLETELY OUT PRIOR TO LEAVING THE CABIN OR RETIRING FOR THE NIGHT.

I agree to NEVER LEAVE A FIRE UNATTENDED!! Do not try to put your fire out with water as water will cause starter logs to explode and damage the fireplace. Please let your fire completely extinguish itself.

If I burn candles, I will burn votive candles in votive holders only. I understand that pillar candles drip and wax damages furniture tops, bed covers and also carpets.

SMOKING IS PROHIBITED on Fire Mountain. I agree that I will not smoke cigarettes, pipes, cigars, vapes or cannabis while I am on the Fire Mountain property.

I understand that Fire Mountain is on a septic system. I will use the sani-bags provided to dispose of sanitary and other personal items that I will place in the waste basket.

DO NOT LEAVE GARBAGE OUT AT NIGHT because it attracts wild animals. Remove your garbage bag from the can and tie tightly at the top. In the mornings leave your garbage bags on your porch for pick-up.

We request that you NOT LEAVE USED OR UNUSED FOOD PRODUCTS in your Cabin. Dispose of these items in your garbage or take them with you.

I WILL NOT MOVE FURNITURE since its takes maintenance time and labor to move it back.

I AGREE TO WASH ALL KITCHENWARE THAT I USE and return all kitchenware to its proper place in cabinets and drawers.

PLEASE HANG ALL TOWELS AND WASH CLOTHS ON TOWEL BARS OR SHOWER RODS since mildew is an enemy that we fight constantly being in a temperate rain forest.

DO NOT POUR GREASE DOWN A DRAIN or OUTSIDE. Under your kitchen sink is a grease can provided for this purpose and for your use. Also pouring grease outside will attract wild animals to your Cabin.

I AGREE TO PAY ANY ADDITIONAL FEES for any of the following: leaving a fire burning unattended, unauthorized pet occupancies, smoking inside any structure, exceeding the occupancy limits in your confirmation letter, additional housekeeping services required or late check-out.

NOTE: Fire Mountain considers DAMAGE as the abuse of a physical object to a point where cost of labor or cost of material is required to bring the object back to normal
